This includes contraception, STI prevention and management safe abortion care and basic care for sexual health.

EBCOG and ESCRH are committed to improve the standards of sexual and reproductive health care globally. This examination is open to all professionals who are practising globally in the field of sexual and reproductive healthcare.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants should have been actively practising in Family planning, contraception and reproductive health care.

Requirement for application

Group 1-2

- Evidence of a registered medical qualification.
- Evidence of good standing from their Medical Regulatory Body, Employing Authority or Head of Department.
- Logbook demonstrating knowledge and skills

Group 3-4

- Evidence of nursing or midwifery qualification and further training
- Evidence of good standing from their Employing Authority or Head of Department.
- Logbook demonstrating knowledge and skills

Group 5

- Evidence of specialist training in OBGYN
- Evidence of good standing from their Head of Department or employing authority.
- Logbook demonstrating knowledge and skills

- Applications are submitted online along with the following documents:
 - Evidence of medical / midwifery / nursing qualification
 - Evidence of current registration of work with local regulatory authority eg:
 - Medical Council or other organization according to the category (midwifes & nurses)
 - Certificate of good standing
 - Identification / Passport
 - Any other documents supporting involvement in SRH care
 - Log of experience
- All submitted documents with the applications must be in English or after an official translation.
- The Examination department will confirm the eligibility
